Consumption of alcohol

In all cases where alcohol will be available but not sold at an event in the Hall, the following provisions apply:

The expression 'minor' shall mean any person under the age of 18 and the Hirer must require proof of age or other identification from any person who appears to be a minor.

The Hirer confirms that he will not:

- supply or permit the supply of alcohol to a minor or knowingly allow alcohol to be consumed by a minor;
- supply or permit the supply of alcohol to a person who is drunk or knowingly allow alcohol to be consumed by a person who is drunk;
- permit any disorderly or drunken behaviour (including any games designed to encourage the consumption of alcohol);
- allow alcohol to be consumed outside the Hall.

The Hirer acknowledges his personal responsibility to comply with the terms of the Licensing Act 2003 and with the Terms and Conditions of Hire relating to the consumption of alcohol in the Hall (including the provisions set out in this form).
